

Equipment and control rooms generally use steel Walker Wallduct. Walker Wallduct can be installed in the wall, revealing only the cover plate. It can also be wall mounted, exposing the entire surface. Walker Wallduct may also be installed overhead to connect cables and wires between rooms. Walker Trenchduct can be used in combination with Walker Wallduct to feed equipment through the floor. 
